COACH EXPECTATIONS

1. Coaches should be held accountable for providing players with the fundamentals needed to correctly learn the basic skills required to play the game of softball. It is understood that the degree of expertise amongst the coaches will vary, but it is expected that the coaches will teach to the best of their ability.
2. Coaches should actively participate in softball clinics and drills funded or presented by the league for the purpose of teaching our players sound fundamental softball techniques.
3. Coaches shall always promote good sportsmanship and attitude. Play hard, but have a fun mentality.
4. Coaches shall refrain from displaying an argumentative approach to our umpiring crew and avoid confrontation with other coaches, players, and teammates. Use the proper chain of command to resolve issues on the field.
5. Profanity by any member of the league, e.g. coaches, players, or parents, will not be tolerated.
6. Coaches will be held accountable for the actions of their players and their players' parents.
7. Coaches shall make every attempt to conduct two (2) practices per week prior to the start of the season. Also, conduct practices as needed during the season to correct any deficiencies in players' skills.
